What information do we collect about you?

Specific Collection of Personal Identifiable Information

The ME Clinic LTD store contact details entailing names, addresses, telephone number and email address along with personal data of anyone who has received or enquired about our services or products.

Any information you do submit allows us to respond to enquiries effectively, manage future communications with new and existing clients or companies to update them with information on our products and services via email, phone, text or direct mail.

The ME Clinic Ltd will only use your data for the purpose for which it was collected and that we do not share your data information with other organisations or sell data to any third party unless requested/advised to do so by you. We can advise The ME Clinic will share your data to third parties in relation to leasing companies to fund services required and with the hospital(s) the clinic is linked with. In these circumstances the data shared will still be subject to confidentiality.

How will we use the information about you?

Personal identifiable information can be submitted to The ME Clinic Ltd and collected from in the following areas; Website, Events, Email, Social Media, Phone, Walk ins, Customer Surveys, Feedback and any participation in competitions.

Enquiry Form / Contact Form / Request Form

These forms are provided as a quick and convenient method for you to contact and link with The ME Clinic Ltd. The information that you submit in the above following areas will be used by The ME Clinic Ltd to answer any questions and information you may have asked or require to provide under obligation.

Consultation/Record Form

These forms are a contractual obligation deeming that you have provided and supplied the correct personal and medical information required to be able to be treated/receive our products and services at the clinic. We advise that it is a requirement to retain patient and client consultation records for up to seven years following the last occasion on which treatment or service was given containing personal information. The retaining of data is necessary where required for contractual, legal or regulatory purposes.

Purchases

In processing your order, we may send your details to leasing companies/agencies as per your request to purchase the product which may also require using information from credit reference agencies and fraud prevention agencies.

Delivery & Invoice Address Forms

The delivery & invoice address form is part of the process required for any purchased products from The ME Clinic LTD. The information collected allows us to fulfil your order by delivering and invoicing goods to the specified address at time of purchase. We advise that we are legally required to store contact details for tax purposes with the data being held securely by us on companies that have purchased products and services from us for the required time by HMRC. Details of request to change to

data formally submitted requires to be provided to The ME Clinic Ltd in writing to addresses available in the 'how to contact us' section.

Credit / Debit Card Payments

The payment system The ME Clinic Ltd utilises to submit your payment details is Worldpay, who are an Internet payment gateway. The ME Clinic Ltd has a formal agreement with WorldPay to accept payments on our behalf. Any information that is submitted to WorldPay is used solely for the purpose of completing your transaction on your purchases from us and will **not** be offered or sold to any further parties.

How long will you hold your consultation records?

We advise that it is required to retain patient and client consultation records for up to seven years following the last occasion on which treatment or service was given containing personal information. The retaining of data is necessary where required for contractual, legal or regulatory purposes.

Website

Automatic Collection of Anonymous Information

When you browse themeclinic.co.uk certain anonymous information about your visit is automatically logged. This may include information about the type of browser you are using, the server name and/or IP address through which you access the internet, the date & time you accessed this website, the pages you accessed, and the internet address of the website (if any) that referred you to themeclinic.co.uk. Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. Cookie	Name	Purpose
User Session	PHPSESSID	This cookie is used to identify you as a user between page loads. It is an essential part of the content management and shopping cart systems on our website. Unless you register and log-in, you will simply be assigned an anonymous user session. This cookie is destroyed each time you close your browser.
Cookie Usage Notice	Cookie Notice	This cookie is used to record if you have read and accepted the notice regarding the use of cookies on our website. If set, this cookie remains active for 100 days and prevents the notice from being displayed again.
Shopping Cart	BASKET REGION DISCOUNT_CODE DELIVERY INVOICE	These cookies are an essential part of the shopping cart system on our website. The BASKET cookie records the items you have placed in your basket as you navigate from page to page. The REGION cookie records your geographical region for the purpose of calculating delivery costs. The DISCOUNT_CODE cookie records a discount code that you may have entered, so that discounts can be applied to your shopping cart. The DELIVERY and INVOICE cookies record your address selections as you navigate the checkout process. All of these cookies may persist between sessions to enable you to resume your shopping at a later date.
Google Analytics	_utma _utmb _utmc _utmz	These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our website. We use this information to compile reports and to help us improve the website. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the website, how visitors arrived at the website and the pages that they visited.
